

## **2020/21 Owerko Centre Trainee Publication Award**

### **Description:**

The Owerko Centre Trainee Publication Award recognizes trainees who have first authored papers focused on neurodevelopment and child mental health over a given year in an impactful and creative way.

**Number of available awards:** 2

**Award value:** \$500 each

### **Eligibility:**

- Undergraduate students
- Graduate students
- Post-Doctoral fellows
- All applicants must have an Owerko Centre investigator as one of their supervisors

### **Application requirements:**

- Trainee must have, as first author, a paper published in a recognized, peer-reviewed journal in 2020/2021
- Trainee must be either a full time post-doctoral trainee, graduate (MSc and PhD) or undergraduate student in good standing at the time of award
- Applicants must have a supervisor who is an Owerko Centre member

### **Application instructions:**

- Completed application form
- A single page publication description as either a Word or PDF file
- Attached copy of applicant's published paper

### **Evaluation criteria:**

Eligible applications will be reviewed by members of the Owerko Centre Executive Committee, in conjunction with the Owerko Centre Education Committee. Applications will be adjudicated based on the following criteria:

- 
- Significance and quality of the publication;
- Demonstration of publication's contribution to the knowledge base in neurodevelopment and mental health in children and scientific impact;
- Applicant's contribution to the publication;
- Alignment of the topic of the publication with the mission, vision, values and goals of the Owerko Centre.
