Study Reveals Evidence for Neural Sex Differentiation in the Fetal Brain and the Impact of BPA Exposure

A recent study in mice challenges the long-held belief that brain sex differentiation occurs around birth. In this paper, **Dr. Deborah Kurrasch** and her team identified an early period important for determining sex, similar to the second trimester in humans. By examining vasopressin neurons linked to sex-specific behaviors, they found that sex differentiation can start before the testes fully develop. The study was published in *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences*. **Read more**

In 2023, ACHRI sponsored a cohort of 7 young adults (YA) living with chronic disease (CD) to complete UCalgary's Patient and Community Engagement Research (PaCER) program. During this 12-month experience-based curriculum, the cohort learned about patient-engaged research (PER) and conducted a qualitative study investigating the experiences of YA living with CD in accessing supports and resources for attending or considering post-secondary education.
