Funded through the One Child Every Child (OCEC) Transdisciplinary Training Accelerator, the **OCEC Graduate Future Leaders Awards** are designed to attract and retain exceptional talents at the graduate level, promote transformational, transdisciplinary research in Child Health and Wellness, and position scholars for success as the research leaders of tomorrow.

There are five awards available:

- Two awards for Master's students: \$38,000 per year for up to 2 years
- Three awards for PhD students: \$40,000 per year for up to 2 years


