Welcome to our newest ACHRI members:

Dr. Tara Beattie lab focuses on telomere integrity and the enzyme telomerase as a critical factor in the progression of age-related diseases. Her research involves

genomic instability and has increasingly been involving hemalogical malignancies and disorders/mutations that have been identified in children.

Dr. Michael Fridman joins the Precision Medicine & Disease Mechanisms Program. Dr. Fridman focuses on understanding the mechanisms of inherited conditions that result in pediatric heart diseases, especially heart rhythm problems that result in sudden death. He uses tools and wearable devices to better predict who are at highest risk of sudden cardiac events and provides more targeted advice to families. He is interested understanding of the genetic basis of heart diseases including novel treatment and potential cures.

Dr. Jennifer Klowak joins the Child Health Data Science Program. Dr. Klowak is a pediatric intensivist and clinician investigator. Her research focuses on care of the critically ill child, with specific interest in resuscitation sepsis, status epilepticus and organ donation.

Dr. Chris Novak joins the Care Transformation for Children Program. His research focuses on medical education and Pediatric Hospital Medicine. In medical education my research looks at online learning and evaluating innovative curricula. His scholarly work also looks at common pediatric problems such as bronchiolitis and febrile infants to find more effective ways to deliver high-value care.

Dr. Aleem Bharwani joins the Healthy Children, Families & Communities. Dr. Bharwani is the co-lead for the One Child Every Child's Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Accelerator. His work in pluralism includes inclusive governance and the diplomacy platform aimed at helping us to live together peacefully, constructively, and creatively – to allow differences to emerge as collective societal assets.

SPARK KNOWLEDGE TO EXCHANGE



Knowledge 2 Empower (K2E), led by Dr. Julia Jacobs-LeVan, is excited to be part of the 2023 cohort of Spark Alberta. K2E is a virtual educational program teaching families and kids about epilepsy. The program is based on short entertaining videos and games. The newest development is a Virtual Reality Scenario to provide participants with an even more immersed experience.

SPARK Alberta is a one-year program supporting evidence-based digital health innovations within Alberta's post-secondary institutions. The team around Dr. Jacobs' team in engaging with Spark to learn about important entrepreneurial skills and brining innovation to the general public. The team wants to ensure that K2E will be sustainable, widely available and continues to grow beyond the current stage.

INCREASE IN POSTDOCTORAL SCHOLAR STIPENDS



Across Canada, we have seen an overwhelming need for postdoctoral scholars' stipends to increase. The ACHRI postdoc stipend of \$50,000 was established in 2016. Over the last five years inflation in Alberta increased the cost of living by ~12 per cent, with further inflation predicted in 2023 and 2024. In recognition of this, ACHRI has increased the value of institute stipends to \$60,000 annually.

"Postdoctoral scholars bring immense value to ACHRI research endeavors, and it essential that we are able to recruit the most qualified candidates," says Dr. Susan Samuel, Education Director - Clinical Research. "They should be paid a living wage commensurate with the qualification of advanced post-secondary training."

"As stipends are co-funded by the supervisor, we acknowledge that this creates an increased burden on already stretched supervisors' research grants," says Dr. Quentin Pittman, Education Director - Basic Research. "For this reason ACHRI has increased its contribution, while supervisors keep their funding commitment at \$25,000."

This change was effective April 1, 2023.
