


NEW ACHRI MEMBER




CALGARY **Women's Health** RESEARCH SYMPOSIUM


FUNDING SUCCESS

Congratulations to **Dr. Derya Sargin**, an assistant professor psychology who has been awarded a Canadian Foundation for Innovation John R. Evans Leaders Fund (CFI JELF) to explore the neurological effects of chronic stress on young brains. Dr. Sargin's research focuses on understanding how brain connectivity changes in response to early life stress. The CFI JELF grant will provide tools to examine and image deep brain regions, allowing the observation of changes to brain activity.



By understanding how chronic stress impacts brain and behaviour, Dr. Sargin's team hopes to inform treatment and intervention strategies for chronic stress in children and youth. [Read more](#)

TRAINEE SUCCESS



Congratulations to **Dr. Benedikt Hallgrímsson's** PhD student in Medical Sciences, **Cassidy Da Silva**, who was awarded "First Runner-up in STEM" and the "People's Choice Award" for the UCalgary [2022 Images of Research Competition](#). Her image explores how modern three-dimensional (3D) imaging systems make it possible to image large numbers of people to investigate diverse research questions. Cassidy's project looks at the biological causes of sex differences in human faces: what makes some people appear more masculine or feminine than others? The results will help us better understand the important problem of sex differences in human health, a topic that researchers still know very

little about. Progress in this area is only possible because of recent advances in 3D imaging technology.

PUBLICATION NEWS

Congratulations to **Dr. Serena Orr** on her publication: [Adverse childhood experiences \(ACEs\) and onset of migraine in Canadian adolescents: A cohort study](#). Using data from the National Longitudinal Survey of Children and Youth, the study explored whether ACEs are prospectively associated with migraine diagnosis and frequent headaches in adolescence, either directly or indirectly through symptoms of depression and anxiety. The study concluded that ACEs may result in an increased risk of migraine onset in adolescence. The association was not explained by symptoms of depression and anxiety in late childhood. The study addresses a gap in the literature by helping to clarify how stress experienced during a developmentally sensitive time may increase the risk of migraine pre-adulthood which will assist in the development of preventative efforts.
