OCEC INDIGENOUS AWARDS RECAP

OCEC's Indigenous Accelerator had an impressive number of applicants for the OCEC Indigenous Undergraduate Award 2025-2026, with more than 249 people applying in just one month. The number of applicants suggests a need and desire for post-secondary supports. Twenty students from biology, Indigenous studies, education, nursing and other faculties were sent acceptance letters.

PATCH PROGRAM LAUNCHES

The Platform Advancements in Technology for Child Health (PATCH) Program—a 3-year Technology Solution Accelerator initiative under One Child Every Child—launched this month, bringing together five outstanding principal investigators leading innovations in pediatric and maternal health. Led by **Drs. Michael Kallos and Adam Kirton**, the OCEC Technology Solution Accelerator connects researchers, clinicians and industry partners to co-develop scalable, real-world solutions that advance child and maternal health.

The cohort includes: **Drs. Junho Park, Mariana Pinheiro Bento, Richa Pandey, Serena Orr and Eli Kinney-Lang.** These projects reflect PATCH's mission to accelerate technology innovation that transforms pediatric and maternal health through collaboration, translation, and real-world impact.
