We are now accepting applications for the 2025 Aisha Rea Clinical Research Fellowship at the Alberta Children's Hospital *Application Deadline: January 20, 2025*

We are excited to announce the **2025 Aisha Rea Clinical Research Fellowship** in Pediatric Vasculitis at the Alberta Children's Hospital, University of Calgary, Alberta, Canada.

Candidates for the research fellowship may be medical subspecialty pediatric residents or fellows interested in conducting research in childhood inflammatory diseases, with preferred applications to vasculitis and Takayasu Arteritis. All applicants must be working within the child health and wellness context. The successful candidate will work closely with investigators at the Childhood Inflammatory Diseases Program at the Alberta Children's Hospital to help transform care and optimize outcomes for children living with inflammatory diseases by integrating best biological and clinical evidence into clinical practice, standardizing treatment and evaluation in care, and enabling clinical and translational research integration.

This application is open to all nationalities who are eligible to work in Canada. The fellowship is a one-year clinical research fellowship with a preference for early career applicants. The expectation is to contribute to the care advancement of patients with Takayasu vasculitis while working along with an interdisciplinary team. Participation in research focusing on vasculitis is a key element of the fellowship. Our center provides ample opportunity to visit research labs and attend vasculitis clinics in both the adult and pediatric hospitals including a combined rheumatology/nephrology clinic. The fellowship program can be individualized according to the interest and needs of the candidate. The annual salary is approximately \$75,000CAD.

This fellowship position is made possible by the generous support of the Rea Family through the Alberta Children's Hospital Foundation and the Alberta Children's Hospital Research Institute.

Successful completion of the fellowship will be recognized with a certificate issued by the University of Calgary, Vasculitis Fellowship Program.
